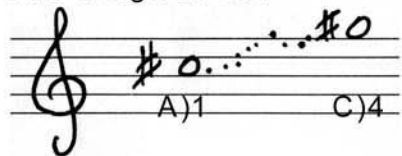


Adagio

for Violin and 12 Wine Glasses

Tune 12 wine glasses with a low of C#
and a high of G#.



Player A) glass #1 is the lowest note of C#
Player C) glass #4 is the highest note of G#

Arrange them in 3 groups of 4 glasses like so:

Wet index finger and glass rim with water.

Rub circumference of the rim until the note appears.

Allow small noises to surface naturally.

Stagger each note entrance with other notes in the ensemble.

Move freely through the series of chords but stay on each for at least 15-30 seconds.

Hold last notes until the resonance of the violin's last notes fade into silence.

Violin:
